H O W W E B R E W O U R T E A

We're a little OCD with our tea. You won't find any tea bags at the Tea Junction. Fortunately, the Island is blessed with good quality soft water, ideal for brewing tea! Not so great is the added chlorine so we filter that back out.

The tea you choose will dictate the water temperature and brewing time. Generally speaking the more delicate whites, greens and oolong teas require a lower temperature and brew time than the black teas and infusions. We take care of the temperature and provide you with a timer at your table so that you can pour your tea at just the right moment.

Some teas can be reinfused more than once, please ask if you would like a hot water top up.

BLACK

Black tea is thought to have been developed during the Ming Dynasty (1368 - 1644). It is the most oxidised of all the tea types and generally has a stronger flavour than other teas. We stock black teas from China, India & Sri Lanka. Most black tea is made from fully oxidised green tea leaves.

ENGLISH BREAKFAST 2.60

Made from a blend of high quality Assam teas, our English Breakfast has a full malty flavour and a rich dark colour.

ASSAM BOP 2.70

Single Estate Broken Orange Pekoe Assam is a great alternative to standard English Breakfast tea. It has a rich, sweet and malty flavour.

CEYLON ORANGE PEKOE 2.70

A very high grade black tea from Sri Lanka. When brewed it gives a light infusion and with extra steeping time can take milk. It has a rich smooth flavour.

BLUE LADY – FLAVOURED BLACK TEA 2.75

Blue Lady is flavoured with grapefruit and pomegranate. It is a great alternative to Earl Grey.

EARL GREY 2.75

Our Earl Grey is made of a base high grade Chinese black tea and scented with a natural bergamot oil producing a traditional classic of outstanding quality.

DARJEELING 2ND FLUSH BOP 2.75

Darjeeling is known as the champagne of teas and is known for its muscatel flavour. This broken leaf tea version is perfect for everyday drinking and infuses strongly enough to take milk.

GOLDEN MONKEY 3.50

Legend has it that Golden Monkey gets its name because it was picked by specially trained monkeys from bushes that were inaccessible to humans. It is made from early harvested young buds which give it its golden colour. This tea is very famous in China and highly regarded as one of the best black teas that China produces.

MANX FAIRY BRIDGE 2.60

A carefully selected, locally packed blend of African and Indian teas produce a pure bright tea, full of flavour, a tasty refreshing cup of tea.

CHOCOLATE AND COCONUT TEA 2.99

Rich black tea with milk chocolate chips, white chocolate chips and coconut flakes. Chocolate and Coconut Tea is an indulgent treat with a smooth, creamy flavour.

LAPSANG SOUCHONG 3.15

A black tea originally from the Wuyi region of the Chinese province of Fujian. It is sometimes referred to as smoked tea. Lapsang is distinct from all other types of tea because lapsang leaves are traditionally smoke-dried over pinewood fires which produces the distinctive smoky flavour. Our Lapsang is hand processed using the best tea leaves and wood for smoking.

VIOLET BLACK 2.75

Aromatic Chinese black tea flavoured with violet and blended with violet blossoms. Violet Tea has a beautiful appearance and a delicate flavour that goes very well with chocolate.

CHAI 2.75

A blend of black tea and spices make this rich & spicy Chai a classic blend.

RUSSIAN CARAVAN 2.85

With its typical aroma this strong Russian blend will remind you of times past when teas were still transported by camel caravans from the land of origin to Russia & Europe. Best served black but can be taken with milk or a slice of lemon.

WHITE

White tea is famous for its mellow, delicate flavour and its smooth mouth feel. Made from young buds and leaves harvested in early spring, white tea is the least processed of all teas and undergoes very little oxidation.

MOONLIGHT WHITE 4.35

Moonlight White is a superb example of Chinese white tea from Yunnan Province. It has a smooth creamy texture and a clean, refreshing and slightly fruity flavour.
